

**Pre-hire checklist for RAV drivers *with* associated HVA documentation included:**

***Rollover Mitigation Procedure  
for Heavy Vehicles***

*As a responsible and conscientious **Heavy Vehicle Driver**, I will employ the following steps (not in any order of priority) to lessen the likelihood of rolling over any heavy vehicle I may be driving:*

1. By maintaining an awareness of the prevailing road, weather and traffic conditions and by adjusting my driving accordingly; i.e. vehicle speed and gaps between other vehicles etc.
2. By not using a handheld Mobile Telephone (or texting), accessing my refrigerator or CD player/GPS whilst driving; by attending to these tasks prior to my departure.
3. By ensuring the vehicle(s) I am driving are roadworthy and by performing a WA HVA compliant pre-journey "**Prestart inspection**" on any vehicles in my heavy vehicle combination prior to setting off on my journey.
4. Ensuring that any "**Serious**" faults logged on the vehicles' Fault Registers have been closed out prior to commencing my journey.
5. By ensuring I am "**Fit for Duty**" and free from the effects of Fatigue, Drugs and or alcohol prior to commencing my journey.
6. By ensuring the **Heavy Vehicle (and its load)** I am driving have their combined centre of gravity at the lowest possible point.
7. By ensuring the vehicle is loaded in accordance with industry **Best Practises** and in accordance with the **Load Restraint Guide**.
8. By running the **Static Rollover Threshold "SRT" Calculator** if it is deemed necessary; the **SRT Calculator** can be found at: <http://apps.mainroads.wa.gov.au/srtcalculator/>
9. By utilising my previous driving experience and general common sense when approaching the driving task.
